There will be two types of contributions: contributed papers and poster presentations. Proposals of contributed papers should not exceed 2000 words and should be submitted by January 31, 2015. Poster proposals should not exceed 800 words and should be submitted by March 30, 2015. Proposals will be selected by the Scientific Committee.
