6th EAAE PhD Workshop, Rome 8-10 June 2015: the deadline for submitting poster presentation proposals, March 31, is approaching. The AIEAA (Italian Association of Agricultural and Applied Economics) and the Department of Economics of Roma Tre University co-organize the 6th PhD Workshop of the European Association of Agricultural Economists (EAAE). The workshop includes 5 plenary keynotes - Giovanni Anania (University of Calabria), Jesus Anton (IFAD), Jean-Cristophe Bureau (Agro-Paris Tech), Thomas Heckeley (University of Bonn) and Steve McCorrison (University of Exeter) - as well as parallel sessions of students' presentations.

More than 120 proposals of contributed papers have been already submitted by PhD students.

The workshop welcomes now submissions for poster presentations by PhD students at any stage of their PhD, as well as students who complete their PhD in 2015. The deadline for poster presentation submission is 31 March.

In the poster sessions, each presentation will be given 15 minutes (with no discussant); presentations are expected to focus on work in progress with preliminary results. Students are not expected to prepare a paper. Proposals are welcome in the areas of agricultural, environmental, food and development economics. Poster presentation proposals, in the form of extended abstracts, should be submitted in English through the workshop website.

The Agricultural Competitiveness and Enterprise Development Project in Moldova (ACED) is planning to organize a study visit to Italy to support a group of 12 participants, including land owners and ACED project representatives, to learn about the opportunities to start successful businesses in agriculture due to the access to irrigation water, including learning about the best practices in the organization and operation of Water User Associations (WUA), financial management of associations, cooperation between similar domestic associations and with public authorities. The main objective of the study tour is to make the participants understand that irrigation can enhance the quantity of output and can enhance the quality of output, demonstrating valuable examples. ACED project is issuing the request for proposal (RfP) and is inviting interested companies/organizations to submit their proposals.

The deadline for receipt of questions is 18:00 on March 25, 2015. Proposals are due no later than 18:00 on April 6, 2015 to be submitted to ACED office – 202 Stefan cel Mare Blvd., 3rd floor, Chisinau, Moldova, MD-2004, delivered in hard copy or via aced_procurement@dai.com. The RFP number and title of the activity must be stated in the subject line of the email, or on the sealed envelope. Late offers will be rejected except under extraordinary circumstances at DAI's discretion. All proposals submitted in hardcopy shall be sealed and labeled with the RFP Number.
