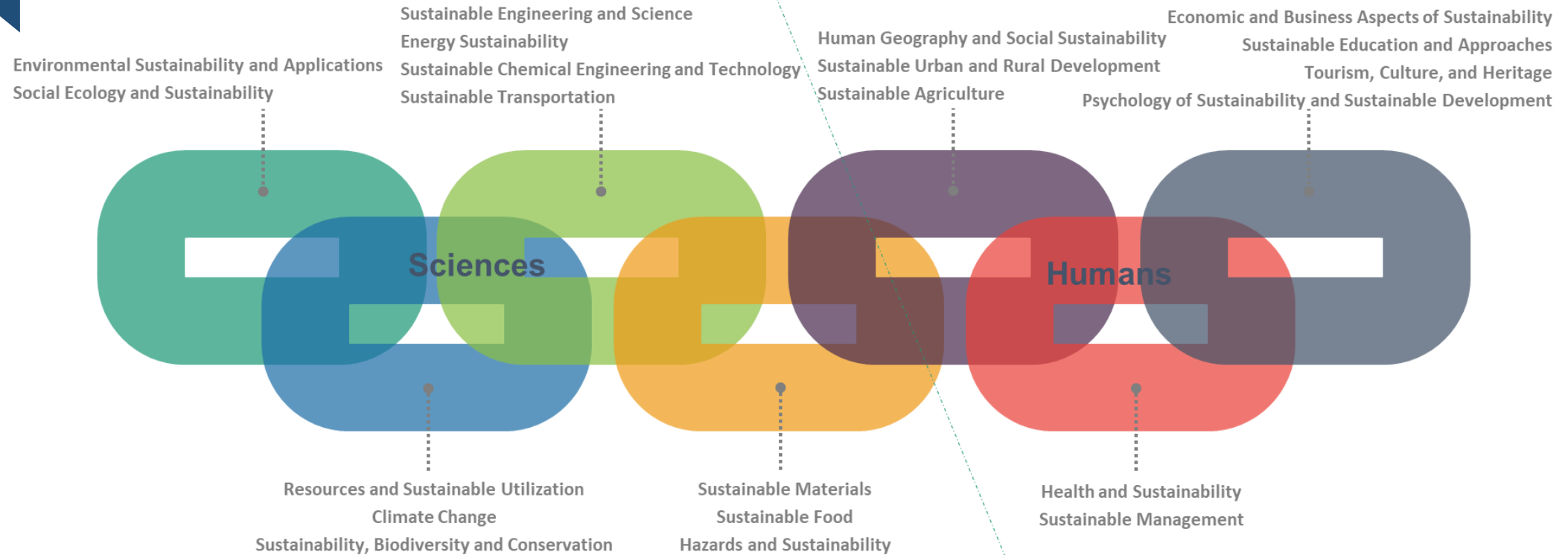

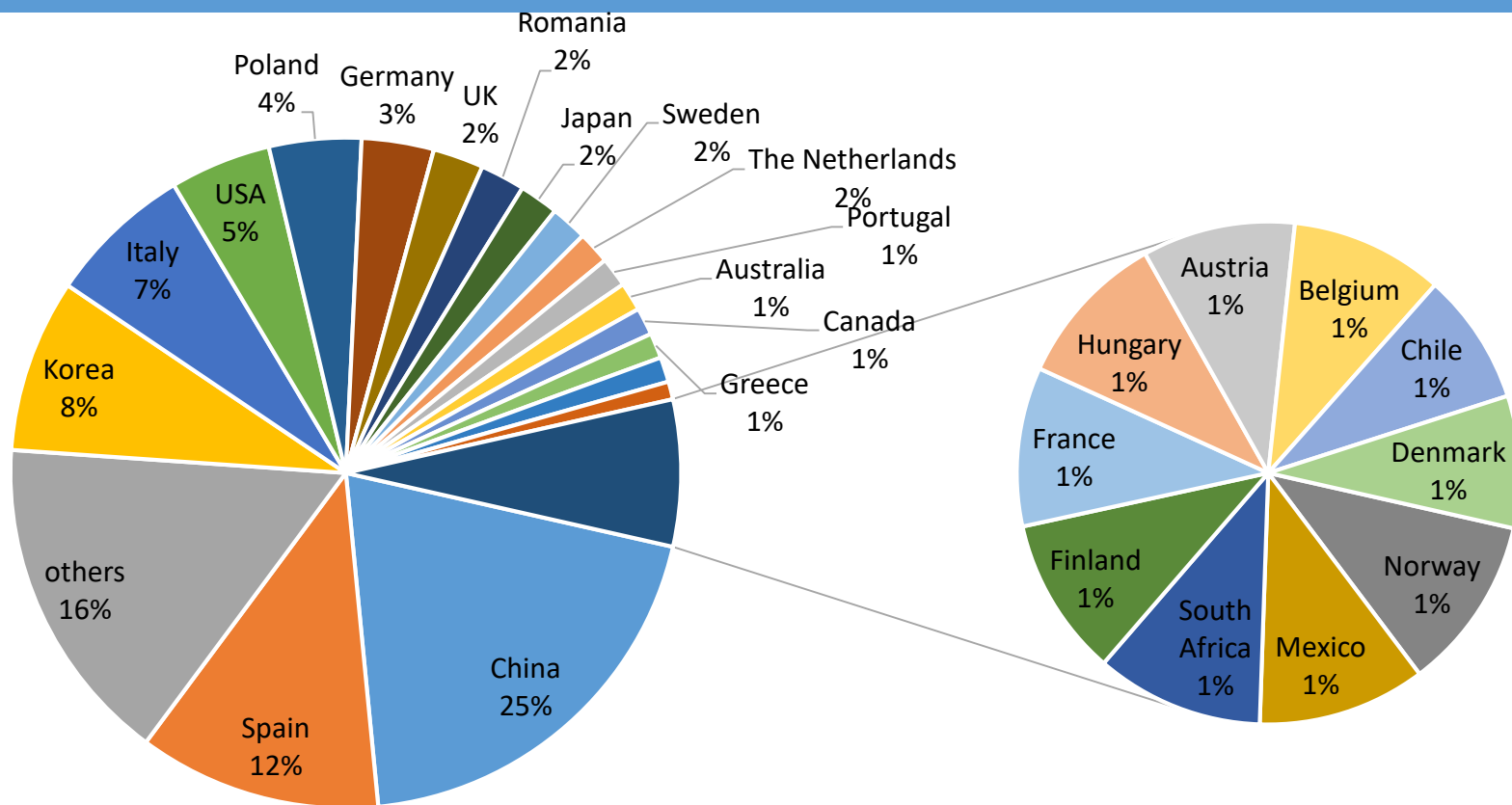

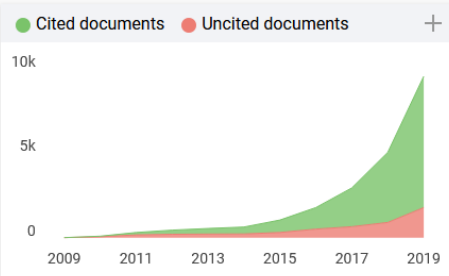

Journal features

- **Open Access**—free for readers, with [article processing charges \(APC\)](#) paid by authors or their institutions.
 - **Rapid Publication:** manuscripts are peer-reviewed and a first decision provided to authors approximately 14.5 days after submission; acceptance to publication is undertaken in 2.9 days (median values for papers published in this journal in the first half of 2020).
 - **Recognition of Reviewers:** reviewers who provide timely, thorough peer-review reports receive vouchers entitling them to a discount on the APC of their next publication in any MDPI journal, in appreciation of the work done.
- It provides an advanced forum for studies related to sustainability and sustainable development, and is published semi-monthly online by MDPI.
- to encourage scientists to publish their experimental and theoretical research relating to natural sciences, social sciences and humanities in as much detail as possible in order to promote scientific predictions and impact assessments of global change and development. Full experimental and methodical details must be provided so that the results can be reproduced

Type of articles

- reviews
- regular research papers
- communications and short notes (there is no restriction on the length of the papers)
- manuscripts regarding research proposals and research ideas
- electronic files or software regarding the full details of the calculation and experimental procedure, if unable to be published in a normal way, can be deposited as supplementary material
- manuscripts communicating to a broader audience with regard to research projects financed with public funds

Special issues

- *Sustainability* runs special issues to create collections of papers on specific topics.
 - The aim is to build a community of authors and readers to discuss the latest research and develop new ideas and research directions.
 - Special Issues are led by Guest Editors who are experts in the subject and oversee the editorial process for papers.
 - Papers published in a Special Issue will be collected together on a dedicated page of the journal website.

Role of Editor

Section editor invites to check a manuscript & the list of suggested reviewers (*)

- continue for peer-review **VS** desk rejection
- confirm or change reviewers

2-3 reviewers report in 15-20 days

- After first round of review
- Accept in current form
 - Accept after minor revision
 - Major
 - Ask for an additional reviewer
- Reject and decline resubmission
- Reject and encourage resubmission

New round of revision and new decision required

- Accept in current form
 - Accept after minor revision
 - Major
 - Ask for an additional reviewer
- Reject and decline resubmission
- Reject and encourage resubmission

Reviewers

- Receive a discount voucher code entitling you to a reduction in the article processing charge (APC) of a future submission to any MDPI journal. Vouchers are linked to your email address and can be applied online at submission or any time before acceptance.
- Receive a [personalized reviewer certificate](#).
- Are included in the journal's annual acknowledgment of reviewers.
- Are considered for the journal's outstanding reviewer award and reviewer board.
- Can build your profile on [Publons](#) and have your reviewing activity automatically added for participating journals. [Publons](#) profiles can also be integrated with [ORCID](#).

Rating the manuscript



Significance: Are the results interpreted appropriately? Are they significant? Are all conclusions justified and supported by the results? Are hypotheses and speculations carefully identified as such?



Interest to the Readers: Are the conclusions interesting for the readership of the Journal? Will the paper attract a wide readership, or be of interest only to a limited number of people? (please see the Aims and Scope of the journal)



Quality of Presentation: Is the article written in an appropriate way? Are the data and analyses presented appropriately? Are the highest standards for presentation of the results used?



Overall Merit: Is there an overall benefit to publishing this work? Does the work provide an advance towards the current knowledge? Do the authors have addressed an important long-standing question with smart experiments?



Scientific Soundness: is the study correctly designed and technically sound? Are the analyses performed with the highest technical standards? Are the data robust enough to draw the conclusions? Are the methods, tools, software, and reagents described with sufficient details to allow another researcher to reproduce the results?



English Level: Is the English language appropriate and understandable?
