Young Economists Session AIEEA

The workshop aims at providing an overview of the relationship between publications and career in academia. This topic is subject of growing interest and debate, where editorial choices for scientific articles are increasingly important for the continuation of a university career. The topics covered in the workshop represent a reason of interest especially for young economists, eager to make the most of the results of their research. The workshop will first provide an overview of the main research topics and editorial choices made by Italian agricultural economists. Then, editors of international agricultural economics journals will provide an overview of the key aspects on which it is important to focus in order to write a successful article. Finally, the workshop will focus on the link between publication evaluation and career in the Italian academic system. In conclusion, there will be time for asking questions and/or clarifications to the different speakers.
