





Scholarship in memory of Giovanni Anania

(Catanzaro, December 9, 1956 – Cosenza, July 15, 2015)

The Italian Association of Agricultural and Applied Economics – AIEAA, the Manlio Rossi-Doria Centre for Economic and Social Research – CRES (Roma Tre University), and the Department of Economics, Statistics and Finance "Giovanni Anania" of the University of Calabria launch a call for application to the Giovanni Anania¹ Scholarship.

The Call is open to applicants who:

- are either PhD students or young scholars who obtained their own PhD degree after 1st January 2018;
- have up to 35 years of age;
- carry out their research activities at an Italian University on any topic related to the field of agrofood economics and policy.

The scholarship amounts to €5,000€ to help cover the expenses of a research period in an academic institution outside Italy. A minimum stay abroad of 3 months is expected, preferably in Fall term 2021/2022 and not later than Spring term 2022. Study and research activities will be supervised by a member of the faculty at the hosting institution.

Applicants must submit a research project using the attached template. The project must be written in English and not exceed 15,000 characters. The project must include the research objectives and methodology, the host institution, the name of the supervisor at the host institution, a tentative workplan and duration of the stay, and a provisional budget with estimated costs and eventual other resources obtained.

Deadline for 2021 Applications is May 31st, 2021. Applications must be emailed to summer.school.anania@gmail.com attaching the following:

- research project;
- CV:

• copy of an identity document;

- certificate of enrolment in a Ph.D. Program or certificate of Ph.D. Degree;
- letter of recommendation of the Ph.D. supervisor and/or of a professor belonging to an Italian University with whom the applicant is collaborating;
- letter of acceptance by the hosting institution.

The selection shall be made by a committee of three members designated by the institutions that have sponsored the scholarship. Selection criteria are: the quality of the research proposal,

applicant's CV and recommendation letters. In case of research projects of equal merit, applicants resident in Calabria will be selected.

Selection results will be communicated to applicants by June 30th, 2021.

The winner shall commit to carrying out the program as indicated in the Call and specified in the project – whose details will be agreed with the participating institutions – under penalty of revocation of the award.

At the end of the period, the beneficiary will; 1) deliver a summary (in English) of the activities carried out and the results achieved at the hosting institution; 2) offer a seminar on the research activities carried out and the results achieved at the hosting institution. Furthermore, publications resulting from research activities carried out, entirely or partially, during the period abroad, should acknowledge the grant received.
